Fiscal 2014 Successes

- APPLICATIONS
 - 359 schools were eligible
 - 269 schools applied
 - 267 schools were approved
 - Total allocated \$3,501,725
 - 20 counties and Baltimore City
- 


Fiscal 2014 Successes

- REIMBURSEMENTS
 - 122 requests for reimbursement received
 - Total requested \$1,240,200 (rounded)
 - Total reimbursed \$1,076,100 (rounded) as of July 30, 2014
 - Deadline to submit Requests for Reimbursement is December 1, 2014

Fiscal 2014 Successes

- Request for Reimbursement Form
 - Take advantage of Excel addition section
 - "Total Request" = "Max. Grant Allocation"
 - Attach IRS Form W-9
 - Attach copy of invoices
 - Attach copy of canceled checks (front & back)
 - Must show bank endorsement stamp
 - May substitute Contractor's Certification Form for canceled check

Fiscal 2015 Program

- Similarities
 - \$3.5 million budgeted
 - Schools eligible for textbook loan program
 - Projects eligible for Public Aging Schools Program
- 

Fiscal 2015 Program

- Major Changes
 - New funding methodology
 - % students eligible for free/reduced price meals
 - Tuition brackets
 - Age of facility
 - Maximum grant up to \$100,000
 - Preschools excluded
 - Schools must be eligible for Fiscal 2015 textbook loan program

Fiscal 2015 Program

- More Differences
 - Online application
 - Preliminary approvals in Fall 2014
 - Final approvals in February 2015
 - Deadline for contracting funds June 30, 2016
 - No exceptions for work in buildings less than 16 years of age
 - Leased buildings eligible with conditions

- Amount of Grants to be Determined by:
 - Projected and historical enrollments and free or reduced price meal program eligibility
 - September 30, 2014
 - September 30, 2013
 - September 30, 2012
 - September 30, 2011
 - Projected and historical total tuition revenue
 - Fiscal 2015
 - Fiscal 2014
 - Fiscal 2013
 - Fiscal 2012

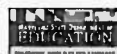

Fiscal 2015 Program

- Project Assumptions
 - Funds for reimbursement available Feb 2015
 - Schools may proceed with work at own expense, at own risk
 - Work must be under contract by 6/30/2016
- Project Information
 - Brief description of work
 - Proposed start and completion dates
 - Estimated cost/estimated grant



Fiscal 2015 Program

- Schedule (target dates)
 - August 8 - procedures & forms posted
 - August 15 - application online
 - September 15 - applications due
 - October - determine funding brackets
 - Nov/Dec - announce preliminary grant awards
 - February 2015 - announce final awards
